

LETTER OF WARNING

CSIC COMPLAINT NO. 08-00085

MEMBER, GERD DAMITZ

I have considered the available information relating to the matter that has entered the complaints and discipline process including your response and the report of the investigator, Mr. Pierre Briand to determine whether a disposition other than a referral to a Discipline Hearing is appropriate in the public interest.

You are found to have breached section 2.6 of the *Complaints and Discipline Policy* by withholding and concealing information reasonably required for the purpose of an investigation by an Investigator.

As a CSIC member, you hold the position of vice-president and member of the executive committee of the Canadian Association of Professional Immigration Consultants (CAPIC). On October 24, 2008, Mr. Briand interviewed you and showed you a list comprised of fourteen CAPIC board directors and asked if any directors were missing from the list. The names of Katarina Onuschak and Ed Dennis were not on the list provided to you by Mr. Briand. You responded that you were not certain as to whether Sol Gombinsky was a director and stated that Bruce Perrault was not a director. You did not identify any board director or directors as missing from the list.

Following the interview and on March 27, 2009 a copy of the unredacted CAPIC board minutes for the June 13, 2008 meeting was disclosed. You were identified as the director who seconded motion # 2 approving the appointment of Sol Gombinsky as Ontario Chapter President and Ed Dennis and Katarina Onuschak as members at large. The minutes listed fifteen members present on June 13, 2008 including Katarina Onuschak and Ed Dennis. The June 13, 2008 minutes also welcomed them as new directors.



As a director you have a responsibility to verify and attest to the accuracy of the board minutes. No amendments to the June 13, 2008 minutes were disclosed during the course of the investigation.

As a CSIC member, you have a duty to cooperate in the investigation and to answer questions asked by the Investigator that may touch upon the matter under inquiry. This duty to cooperate includes refreshing your memory prior to the interview including the review of relevant documents. Your failure to answer the question accurately and to identify the status of Ed Dennis and Katarina Onuschak when you seconded the motion to approve and appoint them as board directors is misleading and amounts to the withholding and concealing of information.

Pursuant to section 3.3(c) of the *Complaints and Discipline Policy* you have been provided with a letter of warning for withholding and concealing information during the investigation. This disciplinary letter will be placed in your membership file.
